

What is a Medical Home approach?



An approach to providing comprehensive primary care that facilitates partnerships between patients, clinicians, medical staff, and families. A medical home extends beyond the four walls of a clinical practice. It includes specialty care, educational services, family support and more.

The medical home recognizes the family as a constant in a child's life and emphasizes partnership between health care professionals and families.

There are several principles involved:

(3) whole-person orientation, including acute, chronic, preventive, and end-of-life care

and more

(1) an ongoing relationship with a personal physician for first-contact, continuous, and comprehensive care



(2) a physician-directed team that collectively cares for the patient
